

2017 Update to the CVFPP

- DWR currently updating the CVFPP
- 2017 CVFPP Update refines the State Systemwide Investment Approach (SSIA)
- More specificity about recommended near- and longer-term investment and financing approaches
- CVFPP will take 30 years to implement and an estimated \$21.3 billion
- Full implementation not feasible without new State, federal, and local funding

- Nearly 20 supporting efforts informing development of the 2017 CVFPP Update
- Stakeholder input essential
- In Yolo County, ongoing meetings with local/regional interests, county staff, supervisors
