### MINUTES of Executive Committee (EC) Meeting Water Resources Association of Yolo County February 9, 2017, 12:00 – 1:00 pm

**Present:** Beverly Sandeen, Roger Cornwell, Kurt Balasek, Tim O'Halloran, Kristin Sicke, Elisa Sabatini and Donna Gentile

- 1. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Chair Sandeen at 12:00 pm.
- 2. Approve Agenda and Adding Items to the Posted Agenda: The EC approved the agenda.
- **3. Public Comment:** No public in attendance.
- **4. Administrative Items:** The EC motioned, seconded and approved all the administrative items by consent.
  - a) January 12, 2017 EC minutes were approved.
  - b) Review financials FY2016-17: January 2017
  - c) Approve payments of invoices: All invoices were approved for payment.
- 5. Update on Water Legislation & Regulatory Issues Tim didn't have any legislative updates. Roger recently returned from Washington, DC along with other local water managers. He detailed discussions from meetings with federal agencies such as the National Marine Fisheries Service and the US Bureau of Reclamation on regulatory issues that could affect the Sacramento River Settlement Contractors and their water operations. He mentioned some regulatory issues that could affect the cities of Woodland and West Sacramento related to Reasonable and Prudent Alternatives (RPA) to the BioOps.
- 6. Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) Planning & Implementation Tim reported on SGMA activities and planning for the two upcoming public meetings scheduled in February. Donna commented on her concerns that the transition from the WRA to the GSA be handled efficiently. Attention will need to be given to the retirement and payroll reporting differences that may be required if the WRA's current organizational structure is changed. Assistance from a QuickBooks advisor may be needed to set-up accounting protocols for new member agencies using the current financial reporting software. She understands that this concern is a bit premature since there are many details to be determined. The next audit period will be through June 30, 2016 and June 30, 2017, which will be a clean transition period for any organizational changes. Tim anticipates a smooth transition with any difficult challenges. Donna informed that the WRA was formally created with each of its member agencies signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Tim asked Donna to forward him the original MOU, which is basically the Association's By-laws.
- 7. Technical Committee (TC) & Westside IRWMP Update: Elisa did not have anything of note to report from the recent TC meeting.

#### 8. WRA Board Meeting:

a) March 20, 2017 - Discuss agenda items: The TC discussed the March agenda and decided to postpone the SGMA update from other counties for a future meeting. The EC acknowledged that a special meeting may be needed between March and the June 30<sup>th</sup> deadline for the purposes of reviewing the GSA agreement. Attention should also be given to the participating eligible entities fiscal year budget timeline and adoption deadlines so that they can appropriately budget for the new GSA dues.
