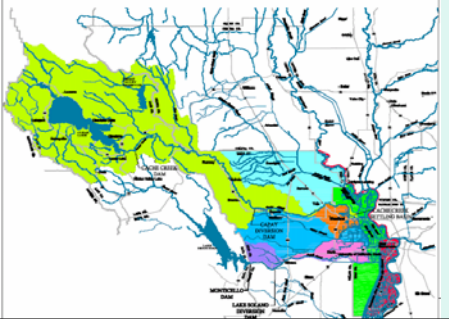

## IRWMP Process

Integrated Regional Water Management Plan

### Where we have been

- Identified issues
- Grouped into five categories: water supply and drought preparedness, water quality, flood management and storm drainage, aquatic and riparian ecosystem enhancement, and recreation
- Developed integrated, stand alone, foundational actions
- Developed implementation strategy
- Allocated grant funding toward work plan development and integrated actions, including Cache Creek
- Identified goals/objectives/issues to be addressed
- Developed final draft IRWMP for public review and adoption by member agencies and WRA Board

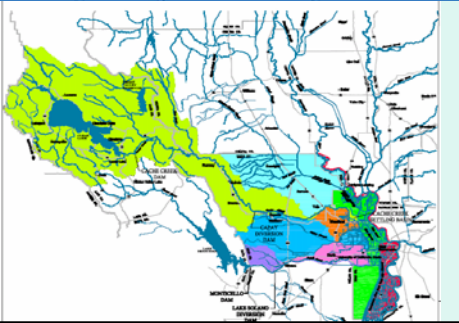
