### **Water Resources Association Hosts an Informative State Water Bond Forum**

(Woodland, Calif.) On Monday, May 17, 2010 the Water Resources Association of Yolo County is hosting an informational forum about the water bond proposition on the November 2010 ballot. All city and county elected officials in Yolo County are invited, as well as all board members of the WRA member agencies. Interested members of the public are also invited.

Three panelists will participate. Water Attorney Paul Bartkiewicz will present an overview of the bond, highlighting the facts of what the water bond entails and what it provides for Yolo County. The Honorable Senator Lois Wolk will discuss why she opposes the bond and ACWA Executive Director Tim Quinn will discuss why the Association of California Water Agencies supports the bond. Woodland City Councilman Bill Marble, who serves as WRA Chair, stated "We are excited to have three very competent panelists presenting the pros and cons of this important ballot measure. The forum will be held from 3:30 to 5 pm on May 17, 2010 at the Woodland Community and Senior Center, 2001 East Street, Woodland.
